In reading we are:

- Picking "just right" books (NOT "uphill" or "downhill" books)
- "Scooping up words" in longer phrases
- Learning about characters, settings, and how illustrations help us understand the text
- Answering "W" questions (who, what, where, when, why)
- Retelling using (The character wanted, but, so)

In writing we are:

- Beginning small moments, narrative writing
- Reviewing writing workshop strategies

In math we are:

- Investigating number lines/number grids
- Skip counting
- Identifying even/odd
- Counting with coins

In science we are:

- PLTW (Project Lead the Way), properties of matter

In social studies we are:

- Discussing growth mindset and how to train our brain
- Beginning our unit on geography, communities, and mapping
