What We're Learning

In <u>reading</u> we are:

- Learning about characters, settings, and how illustrations help us understand the text
- Answering "W" questions (who, what, where, when, why)
- Retelling using: the character wanted, but, so
- Using word solving strategies (Ex: Does that sound right? What is happening in the story? Finding words within words)

In writing we are:

- Beginning small moments, narrative writing
- Reading mentor texts to become narrative writer's ("Ralph Tells a Story," "Fireflies," and "Rollercoaster")
